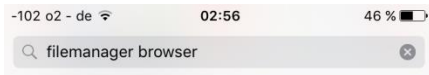
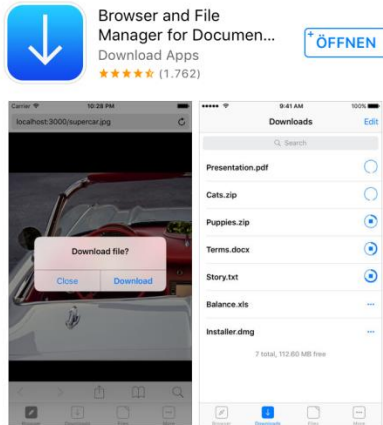


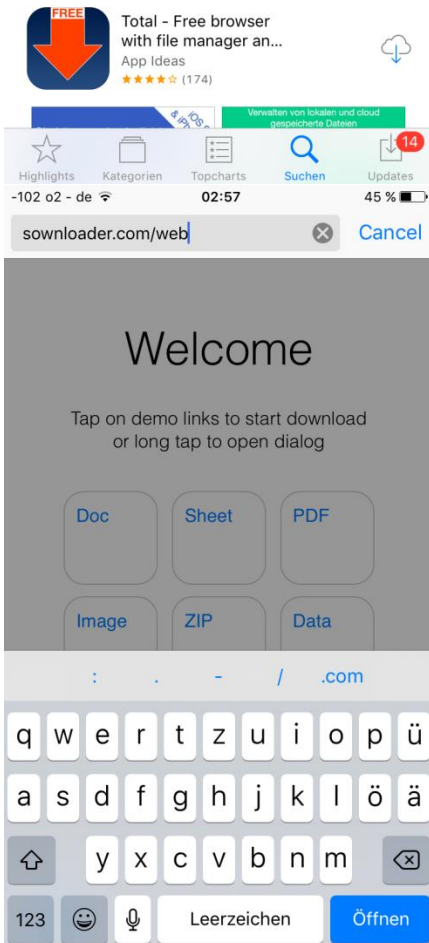
1 How do I download to my iPhone with Sownloader Web?



To save media files on your iPhone you'll need to install a third party filemanager with a built in browser.

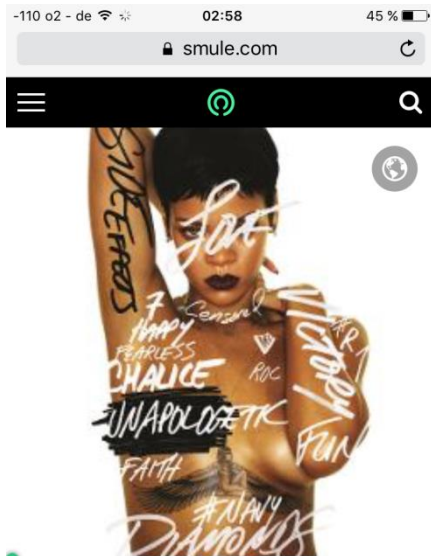


For this tutorial we use the simple app *Browser and File Manager for Documents* by *Download Apps* ([App Store](#)) because it is free and it doesn't contain any kind of annoying ads which can confuse the user.

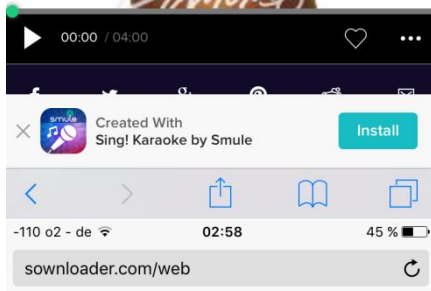


Next you have to navigate within the app to www.sownloader.com/web

2 How do I download to my iPhone with Sownloader Web?



Afterwards you have to press your home button and open up *Safari*. In *Safari* you have to navigate to your *Smule* performance that you want to download. Copy the address of this page by tapping in the address bar, selecting all the text and choose *Copy*.

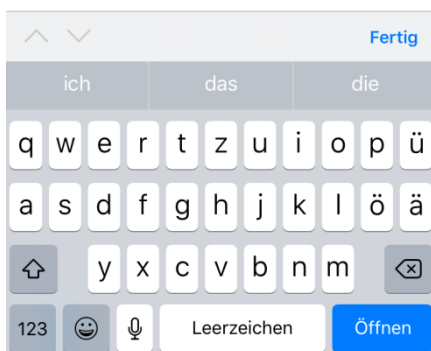


Then double tap your home button and switch back to *Browser and File Manager for Documents*, where you tap the textbox in Sownloader Web and paste your performance in.

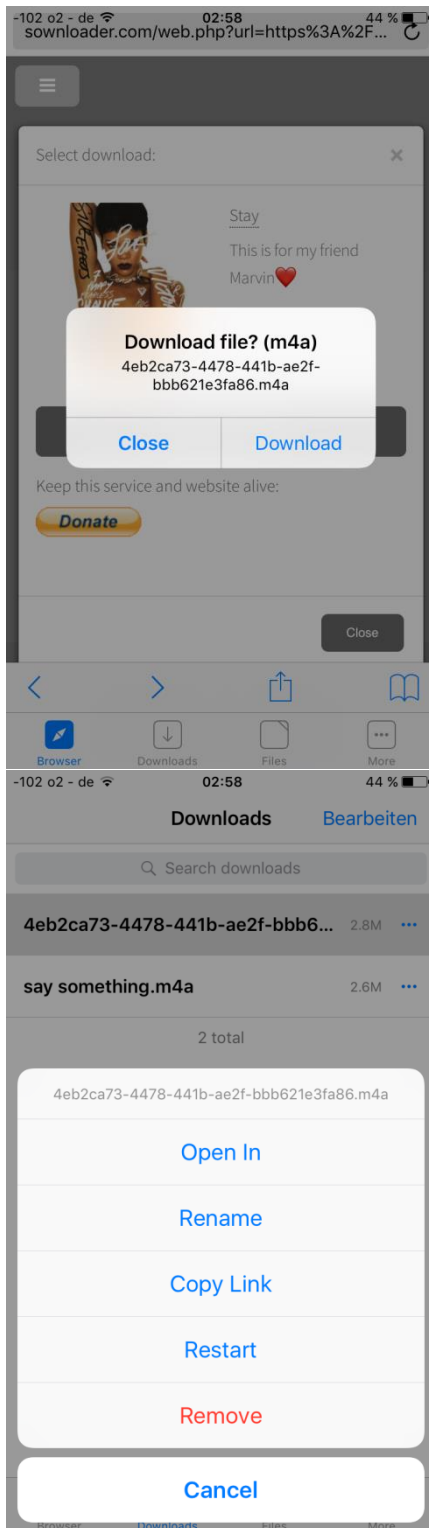


Subsequently touch on *Get file* and select either video or audio download (video is only shown if the performance is available as video).

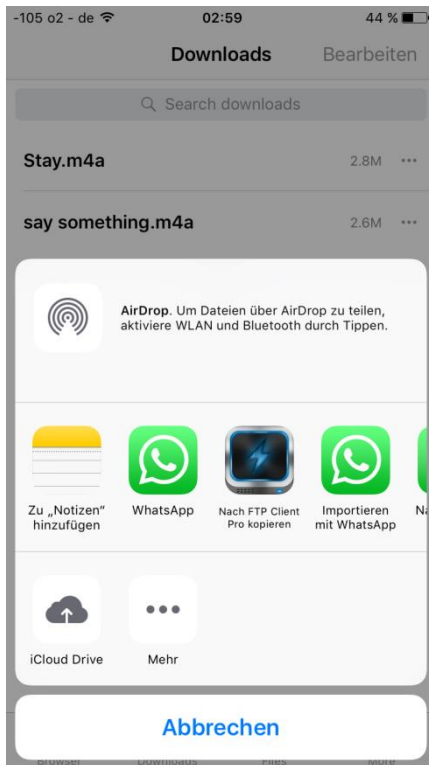
3 How do I download to my iPhone with Sownloader Web?



A pop up will appear where you have to confirm the download, followed by the media player which starts playing the song. Tap on the top left corner on *Finish* and then on *Download*.

Once the download has finished, you can tap the three dots to rename your file. You need to take special care that you don't change the file extension (.m4a/.mp4), otherwise the file will be corrupted and can't be played with a media player.

Last but not least press the three dots again followed by *Open In* to share your media file to other apps or your *iCloud drive*.
